

Getting to MCEC

MCEC is just a 20-minute drive from Melbourne's Tullamarine Airport, ideally located on the banks of the Yarra River.

A short walk or tram ride to the city centre, MCEC is close to Melbourne's best restaurants, cafes, parklands, galleries and museums.

Transport Options

Arriving by tram

Catch any of the following trams and jump off at stop 124A Casino/MCEC, which is right opposite the Clarendon Street entrance of MCEC:

Route 96 – St Kilda to East Brunswick
Route 109 – Port Melbourne to Box Hill
Route 12 – Victoria Gardens to St Kilda

Alternatively, catch tram number 48 or 70 and get off at Stop D5-South Wharf/Wurundjeri Way. From here, MCEC is a short walk towards the Yarra River across the Seafarers Bridge.

Arriving by train

The closest train station to MCEC is Southern Cross. From there, simply catch tram number 96, 109 or 12.

As above, these stop outside the Clarendon Street entrance of MCEC.

Arriving by bus

Bus route 237 operates from Queen Victoria Market, via Southern Cross Station to Lorimer Street South Wharf from Monday to Friday. Lorimer Street is approximately a 5-minute walk to MCEC.

There is also a coach pick-up/drop-off point at Bay 1, Convention Centre Place (closest to DFO South Wharf).

Arriving by taxi or ride share

Exhibition Centre: Ask your driver to drop you off at 2 Clarendon Street – the main MCEC entrance.

Convention Centre: Ask your driver to drop you off at 1 Convention Centre Place, next to the Pan Pacific Melbourne hotel.

Parking at MCEC

If you're travelling to the venue by car, we have five car parks to choose from:

Exhibition Centre basement car park enter via Normanby Road

Siddeley Street car park enter via Siddeley Street

Montague Street car park enter via Munro Street

South Wharf Retail car park enter via Convention Centre Place or Munro Street


Freeway car park enter via Munro Street or Normanby Road

The Exhibition Centre basement car park is primarily for visitors. Therefore, we ask that you encourage your exhibitors to park at the Siddeley Street car park.


