

Teaching Fellowship Program

VET DEVELOPMENT CENTRE | 2024



The Teaching Fellowship aims to provide an immersive experience for teachers with a minimum of three years teaching practice, by providing a comprehensive development program which builds on their teaching practicum and educational leadership capability. Applications will only be received from training organisations that have a 2024 Skills First contract.

The program provides Teaching Fellows with focused support in professional development so that over time, they can make a significant contribution to the growth of the teaching professionalism in VET, improving outcomes for students, industry, and the community.

2024 Program

The Teaching Fellowship Program will consist of several components:

Fellows undertake a comprehensive learning program over 3 months. The development program includes an appropriate course of teacher training, professional development and other learning activities provided by VDC.

In 2024, the topic areas for professional learning include:

- /// Engaging students with technology in training.
- /// Advanced Teaching Practice.
- /// Artificial Intelligence in teaching practice.
- /// Managing Yourself and others.
- /// Innovation in teaching practice.
- /// Sustainability Development Goals.
- /// An accredited unit of competency.
- /// Supported with reflective practice.
- /// Attendance at the VET National Teaching & Learning Conference 2024.

Eligibility Criteria

- WET Teachers with a minimum of three years teaching practice.
- /// Must be employed under long-term arrangements with full or part-time teaching duties.
- /// Application must be endorsed by CEO of RTO.
- /// Shortlisted applicants are required to attend a panel interview.

Application Process

- /// Applications open: Thursday 14 March.
- /// Applications close: Wednesday 24 April.
- /// Shortlisted applicants: interviews to be held at VDC, Monday 6 May.
- /// Notification of outcome: by Wednesday 15 May.
- /// Teaching Fellowship Program commences: Wednesday 22 May.

The Victorian Skills Authority (VSA) funds the VET Development Centre (VDC) to provide opportunities to the Victorian workforce at Skills First providers.






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
